CHANCELLOR'S MESSAGE



Pakistan's 240 million people reside across its 37 administrative divisions, including the six divisions of Sindh. Among these, the Mirpurkhas Division—comprising the districts of Mirpurkhas, Umerkot, and Tharparkar (Mithi)—is a region of notable historical and geographical significance. It is home to the Thar Desert, the largest desert in Pakistan, and shares an international border with India, which the historic Tharparkar–Monabao railway line crosses. The area is also of profound archaeological importance, with sites such as Kaho Jo Daro dating back to the same era as the ancient civilizations of Mohenjo-Daro and Harappa, marking it as one of the oldest continuously inhabited regions in the world.

From an educational perspective, the following milestones underscore the remarkable transformation and progress of this region:

1. For the first five decades following Pakistan's independence in 1947, the Mirpurkhas Division had no medical or professional colleges. This changed with the establishment of the Muhammad Foundation Trust (MFT), which founded Muhammad Medical College (MMC), which became the first medical and professional college of the division. Today, MMC remains the largest private medical college in Sindh outside Karachi, spanning 36.36 acres, and is the oldest among such institutions.
2. For 75 years, the division lacked a university. This gap was filled in 2022, when the Sindh government passed legislation to establish Ibn e Sina University Mirpurkhas (ISUM)—a historic milestone. The university's constituent colleges include Muhammad Medical College (MMC), Muhammad Dental College (MDC), Muhammad Institute of Physiotherapy & Rehabilitation Sciences (MIPRS), Muhammad College of Nursing (MCON), and Muhammad Institute of Business Administration (MIBA). The privilege of being the first University of the division will stay forever.
3. In the first half-century of Pakistan's history, there were virtually no medical or dental specialists with higher diploma in the region. Following MMC's establishment, the next 25 years saw 248 doctors obtaining advanced diplomas and serving in Mirpurkhas—an achievement that is nothing short of extraordinary.
4. Initially, MMC relied almost entirely on faculty recruited from other regions. Today, more than half of its academic staff comprises doctors who either completed their postgraduate training while serving at MMC or were formerly students of the institution—a testament to its role in fostering local expertise.
5. Under the leadership of ISUM's Chancellor—a Professor of Surgery for two decades and now also a Professor of Medical Education—innovative pedagogical methods have been introduced. These efforts earned Muhammad Medical College and the Chancellor himself, Medals of Distinction from the Pakistan Association of Private Medical & Dental Institutions (PAMI), recognizing their contributions and declaring them pioneers in innovative medical education in the region.

Today, concerted efforts are underway to elevate ISUM and its constituent colleges to higher academic rankings. This website is another step towards the same direction. We sincerely welcome your support and encouragement in achieving this ambitious goal.

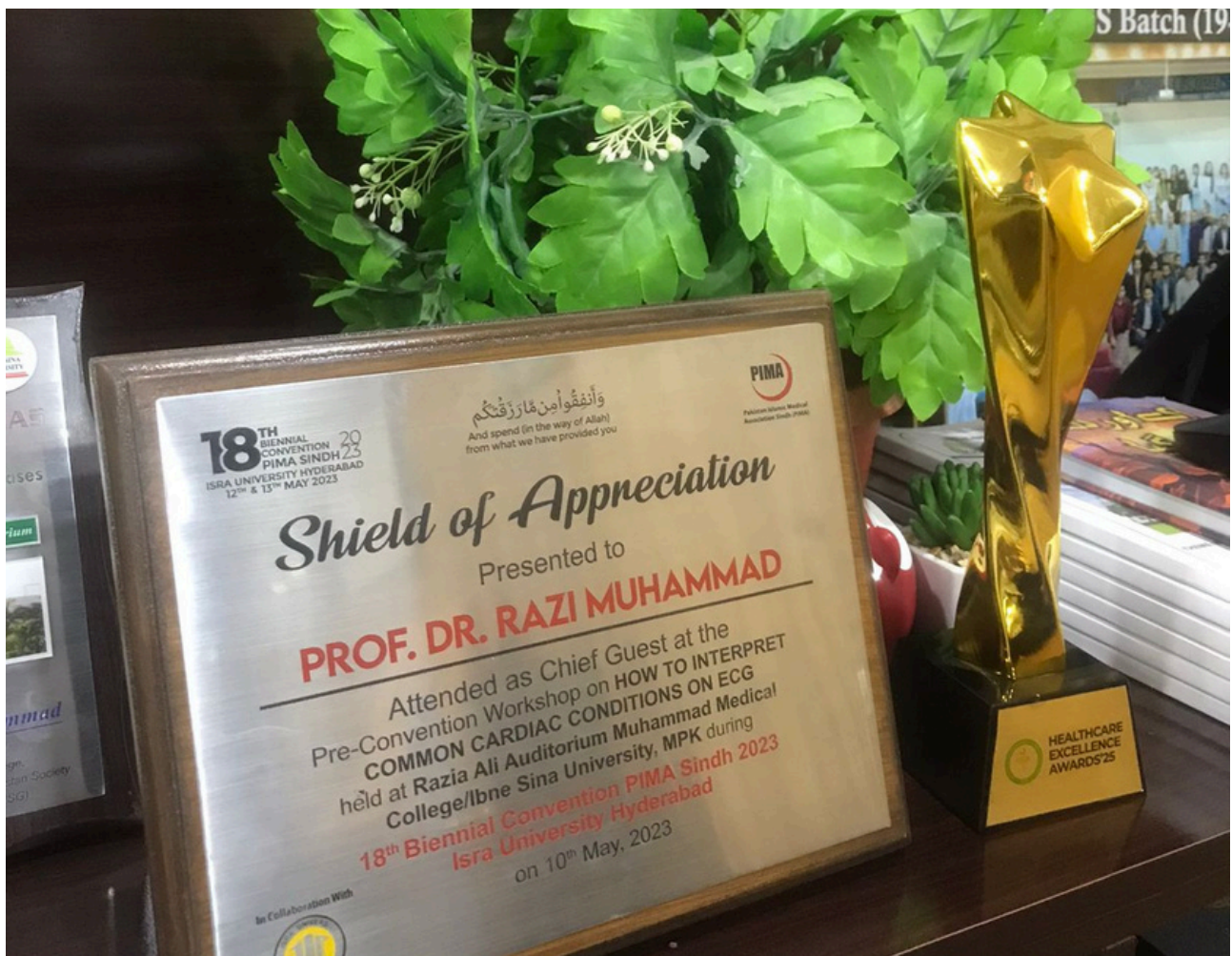

Gastroenterology Conference



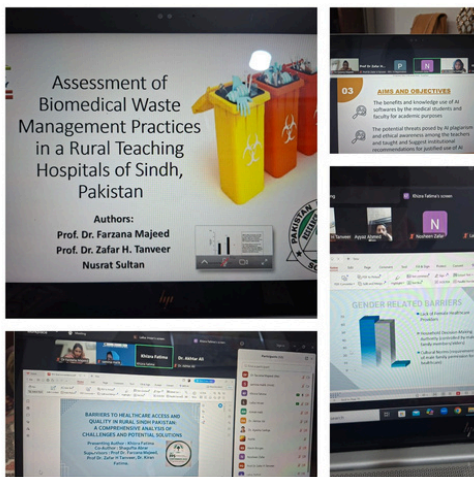
